REFLECTION

- God welcomes your honesty. He wants you to pour out your heart.
- What emotions have you been hiding from God?
- Do you know you can cast all your cares on him?

Psalm 84:11

REFLECTION

- It is not a punishment. It's preparation.
- In what ways could God be protecting or shaping you in this season?
- Are you willing to go where He leads?



But I want you to be free from concern. The unmarried man is concerned about the things of the Lord, how he may please the Lord

1 Corinthians 7:32

REFLECTION

- You have time now to grow in ways others may not. Use it wisely.
- What's one spiritual or personal goal you can pursue right now?
- What are you going to do with the time God gave you?

He has also planted eternity [a sense of divine purpose] in the human heart [a mysterious longing which nothing under the sun can satisfy, except God]—yet man cannot find out (comprehend, grasp) what God has done (His overall plan) from the beginning to the end.

- What part of your story do you need to surrender to God's timing?
- Will you be ready when he calls?
